Job Description

Reporting to the Executive Director, The Lead Hand will take direction from the House and/or Harbour Master to ensure the proper upkeep of the Club inside and out. In addition to being hardworking and energetic, the Lead Hand will be flexible in rotating through functions as determined by the Executive Director on a weekly basis. In addition to maintenance duties, the Lead Hand may be called upon to communicate between the Executive Director, House/Harbour Master and maintenance team.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Be a leader and role model for junior RLWYC team members
- Create daily and weekly maintenance lists and manage the execution to deadline.
- Schedule maintenance staff.
- Manage maintenance labour budget.
- Participate and lead your team in delivering in the following:
 - Set up and take down for events (moving furniture, table & chair set up)
 - Exterior Club maintenance including but not limited to pressure washing, web removal, deck maintenance.
 - Site maintenance including but not limited to garbage management and removal, cleaning & maintaining storage areas, clearing & maintaining paths, maintaining play structures, flower planting and maintenance.
 - Dock maintenance including but not limited to repairing boards, cleats and bumpers.
 - Interior Club maintenance including but not limited to washing floors, laundry, bathrooms & windows.
 - o Identify maintenance issues and address those within ability.
 - Identify and escalate maintenance issues beyond ability.
 - Assist members with docking during busy drop off and pick up times
 - Pick up and delivery of food, liquor and supply orders
- Act as liaison between Managers, Executive Director, House/Harbour Master and maintenance team as necessary.
