Job Overview

The Sailing Instructor will be responsible for teaching sailing lessons at RLWYC, contributing to the development of the sailing program, and promoting RLWYC's sailing and racing initiatives. This position involves planning lessons, coaching students, and managing sailing-related activities and facilities. The Instructor works closely with club leadership and staff to provide high-quality experiences for members.

Both part-time and full-time roles are available. Weekly hours will vary based on your sailing experience, teaching qualifications, and demand for lessons. Scheduling will be communicated weekly.

Key Responsibilities:

- Plan and deliver sailing lessons, both on the water and in a classroom setting, for students aged 6-16.
- Participate in the Club Series Race program at least three times per season, either as a competitor or a race committee member.
- Actively promote the Sailing Program and work to ensure all classes are fully booked.
- Organize and oversee sailing equipment and facilities.

Preferred Qualifications and Skills

- **Age:** Must be at least 16 years old.
- **Certifications:**
 - Sail Canada CANSail 1 & 2 (3 & 4 preferred).
 - PCOC (Pleasure Craft Operator Card), First Aid Certificate, and Boat Safety Course (renewable every three years). Equivalent international certifications may be considered.
- **Registration:** Proof of annual registration with Sail Canada (reimbursed by RLWYC). This ensures you can award CANSail levels and have liability and accident insurance.
- **Experience:** Previous experience mentoring or supervising other instructors is an asset.
- **Skills:** Strong communication and teamwork abilities are essential.
- **Transportation:** Must arrange your own travel to and from RLWYC.
- **Other:** Must have a valid Social Insurance Number (SIN).
